

**★ The BJCC has earned the STAR Facility Accreditation for sanitation procedures from Global Biorisk Advisory Council.**




### Holiday Spectacular @ Regions Field

## SHOPPING

### *The Summit*

Nothing says the holidays like a wild spending spree. Knock out your list in no time in this extensive open-air mall with 100 stores, along with good restaurants for hungry shoppers. This one million square foot shopping experience is so upscale that they call it a lifestyle center. Whatever you call it, it's the fine place to spend a day or two. ### *Mountain Brook*

Fondly known as "The Tiny Kingdom," the Birmingham suburb of Mountain Brook has well-curated shops and boutiques.
